





This competition will focus on Floor & Vault only and is inclusive of all genders, abilities and disabilities.

The minimum age on the date of the competition is 2020 birth year and for gymnasts who are **not** competing at a high level. Gymnasts should train a maximum of 4 hours per week.

About the competition

- Every gymnast will receive a medal and a gift for participating.
- We host in a very encouraging and relaxed environment, hoping all gymnasts build confidence and gymnasts along with their families enjoy their competition experience.
- Gymnasts can wear their club leotards, along with any colour accessories, glitter, colourful eyeshadow etc. Shorts are permitted.
- If gymnasts would like to make a colourful number to show to the judges they are able to do so. It is not essential but there will be a prize each round for the most unique and creative numbers. Numbers will be available to show judges to identify those who do not have their own.
- **New for 2025** The competition will be split into 2 categories, 1-2 hours or 3-4 hours trained to ensure fairness.

Parking

There is no parking inside the venue, it is parking along the residential roads. Please allow enough time if you are travelling by car, to find your parking spaces and travel to the venue.

Competition Entry Fee

£27.50 per gymnast.

Timings

Timings and rounds will be completed and sent two weeks before the competition date.

Spectator fees

£5 per person. Under 5's are free.

Judges

- A judge should be supplied along with your gymnast entry. Within our events we set aside a proportion of spectator fees to pay the judges for their time. Depending on the number of gymnasts competing and the length of the day this is usually between £60 £100 for a full day.
- Judges do not NEED to have a qualification. However this of course is very beneficial for the most consistent judging. Experience in gymnastics however is essential for a judge. Where possible we always put 2 judges together from different clubs for even and mutual judging.
- This is a colour crazy competition so judges can wear as much colour as they'd like no need for standard judging smart suits!
- If you do not supply a judge you must pay the missing judge fee accordingly:

Cut off Entry Date

All entries must be made on or before the 6th March 2025. If the competition becomes full sooner than this date, entries will be closed. If you have shared interest we will let you know if this becomes the case.

How to enter

Fill in the entry form and attach with the booking form on the website. You will be sent a direct payment link to make payment and this will secure your entry.

Please note, any changes after the closing date will not be facilitated. This includes changing gymnasts levels, adding extra gymnasts etc.

- Gymnasts will compete in age appropriate, ability and hours trained levels.
- Boys are eligible to enter and compete. If enough boys enter they will have their own categories to go against each other.
- Floor is not to music but should contain artistry.
- Floor is T2K foam roll, 2m wide, 12m long (not sprung).
- Vault run up is 6-8 meters long.
- For girls Shorts over leotards are optional.
- For boys if they have a unitard this would be preferable, however if they do not then a t-shirt and shorts is fine. No tracksuit bottoms.
- All long hair must be tied up and no jewellery is to be worn.
- Gymnasts get two competition vaults.
- The judging decision is final. If you would like to query a score, please see head judge on the day.
- Upon entry, if a gymnast pulls out and can not be replaced before entry closing date we are unable to refund the entry fee.
- This event is insured by Sports Cover UK. It does not cover individual gymnasts for accidental injury policy. If participants wish to purchase this they are welcome to.
- All coaches must be qualified to teach the skills, and have their own current insurance & DBS.
